
Kindergarten students work on creating force and motion in the Maker Space! Students use the Maker Space to explore scientific concepts.

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Snowy Owls- Third Grade

December is going to be a very busy month for 3rd graders, but exciting as well! Starting the week of December 11th, we will be taking the District Quarterly exams. Students will be tested on all of the standards we have been working on this quarter in Reading, Writing, Math, and Science. The last week before winter break, we will have our Hot Chocolate Reading Celebration for all students who have met at least 4 Power Goals this quarter!

As for what we're currently learning, students are continuing to study the Regions of the United States in Social Studies, and the Properties of Matter in Science. We finished up our Fun Folktales Reading Unit right before Thanksgiving, and we are now reading texts relating to Native Americans. There is a heavy focus on identifying the Main Idea and Key Details within these stories! In Math, we are still working on the various multiplication and division strategies in Module 3. We have also started timed multiplication fact tests for students to build up their fact fluency. It's always beneficial to practice those multiplication facts at home, as often as possible. (There's tons of apps and websites available to use.) In our next math module, students will explore Area of 2D Shapes, which requires them to know their basic multiplication facts.
