We are well into the  $3^{\rm rd}$  Quarter and very busy in  $3^{\rm rd}\,{\rm Grade}!$ 

In the past few weeks we have been reading a variety of fictional texts and focusing on finding the central message of the stories. We are moving onto some informational texts to work on main idea and key details, as well as text features.

In Social Studies, students are working on Economics, including needs vs. wants and supply and demand. Our current Science unit deals with Energy concepts.

After finishing up the Area Module in Math, we are now learning about fractions. This module starts out simple with equal parts and unit fractions, and will move into more challenging skills such as equivalent fractions and fractions on a number line.

This quarter, third graders are working towards a Root Beer Float Reading Celebration by completing at least 4 Power Goals this quarter! So, make sure to keep reading at home as much as possible.
