

Our Snowy Owls are flying into February!

Third grade enjoyed our field trip to see the play "Laura Ingalls Wilder" at the Performing Arts Center at Wesley Chapel High School. What a great way to learn about how life was in the 1870's by watching actors take us back in time!

In Math, our students are working on partitioning a whole into equal parts, understanding fractions in relation to the whole, and comparing fractions. We will soon be using number lines to understand and compare fractions as well. Please continue to work on fact fluency!

In Language Arts, our students are reading stories and scientific texts that explain how and why things happen in the world. We are working to better use text evidence to understand and find main ideas and key details, comparing and contrasting texts, and finding facts and opinions in text. We are also beginning to write to write opinion pieces as well as informational observations.

Please continue to support your child's reading growth by reading nightly at home and working on reading goals and reading STAMINA. *Book Taco, ReadTheory,* and *RazKids* are great comprehension checks and will help prepare your third grader for the upcoming FSA Test!

In Science and Social Studies, we are learning about Earth Sciences, specifically space and how the universe is composed of many different objects including stars, gases, dust, planets, and galaxies. We are also learning about Economics and the importance of producers, consumers, goods and services, and even supply and demand in our world.

Be on the lookout for information coming home with your child regarding valentine exchanges!


How you can help your child:

First, we would like to thank our students for all of their hard work in this year's TED X Talks! All students gave great presentations. We want to recognize 5th grader, Kelsie V. for winning the school competition and going on to represent Watergrass at the District Talks! We have some excellent events coming up for the month of February as well, including a trip to Saint Leo University!

We will be starting a new science unit in February. This unit is all about Force and Motion. Please continue to have your child review their science notes nightly to instill good study habits. They are also encouraged to get on Discovery Education for more science practice. The students should be finishing their work on their STEM Fair projects. All students should follow the description of this project along with a copy of the rubric for due dates. Please note that final projects are due on February 22nd.

In math, we are working on Module 4 which focuses on multiplying and dividing fractions. Remember, math fluency is vital for your child's success in math. Please continue to work on automaticity of multiplication facts. Students can utilize Zearn and Fast Math to assist with their math fluency.

Continue to promote good reading habits with your child. Students have an individual reading power goal to help them track their successes in their level. Ask your child what their POWER GOAL is and please use this power goal to work with your child at home during their 30 minutes of reading each night. We also would like to encourage our 5th graders to read nonfiction text in order to expand their vocabulary knowledge.

Finally, please remember that student planners need to be signed daily. We'd also like to remind students to continue to work to their full potential in all areas. Encourage your child to give their best effort all of the time.
